Restrictions	In accordance with the State Code of West Virginia, only those persons 18-40 years of age at the time of application may be considered. Veterans should present a copy of their DD_214 upon application to be considered for veteran's preference points
Deadline	Applications will be accepted until, Friday, February 17, 2012 at 4:30 p.m. At Beckley City Hall in the office of the Recorder / Treasurer.

Test Date

The Policeman's Civil Service Commission of the City of Beckley will be giving an entry level Probationary Police Officer test on Saturday, March 3, 2012. The test will begin at 9:00 a.m. and will be given at the Beckley-Raleigh County Convention Center, Incorporated

Applications must be received by the deadline in order to take the exam. Photo Identification required.
